PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, prostate cancer is the number one cancer among men, and the second leading cause of cancer-related deaths among men in the United States; and

WHEREAS, approximately 180,000 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer this year and over 26,000 will die from it; and

WHEREAS, African-American men, men with a family history of prostate cancer, and men exposed to Agent Orange, are at higher risk; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States proclaims September as National Prostate

Cancer Awareness Month each year; and

WHEREAS, prostate cancer not only affects men but also affects their family and friends;

and

WHEREAS, prostate cancer is usually treatable if detected early; and

WHEREAS, early stage prostate cancer usually has no symptoms; and

WHEREAS, men who are educated about the value of early detection will be more likely

to have the cancer detected when it's treatable; and

WHEREAS, men who discuss treatment options with their health care provider and with

their family are more likely to make good treatment decisions; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Prostate Cancer Awareness Month will encourage men to discuss

prostate cancer with their health care provider; and
